Pastor's Report

February 12th, 2025

- 1. Ash Wednesday is but a mere 3 weeks away from today. We will be participating in a preaching round robin again this year with the help of other preachers in the area. Our theme for this Lent will be Guided by the Cross, and the liturgy setting will be Holden Evening Prayer. I believe we will worship in this order:
 - a. March 12th, First Lutheran
 - b. March 19th, St. Jacobs
 - c. March 26th, First Lutheran
 - d. April 2nd, St. Jacobs
 - e. April 9th, First Lutheran
- 2. It will be time for our 5th graders to have their 1st Communion on Maundy Thursday, April 17th. We will have the Milestone training on April 5th at 10:00am. There we will learn about Holy Communion; what it is, what it isn't and how to best receive Communion.

a. Also, students will be decorating their own little chalices as a reminder of this important milestone in their life of faith.

- b. They will also be making Communion bread.
- Confirmands will not be meeting during the season of Lent. Instead, they will be taking sermon notes. Confirmands will also be helping serve at the Westside Banquet on the 26th. Youth Group is scheduled to follow at 1st, unless something changes.
- 4. Book club will be meeting on February 19th @ 5:30pm. We will discuss chapters 8, 9 and 10.
- 5. I have a couple of thoughts looking at worship practices. With our CCLI license, we can create our own songbooks. I was curious if this was something that we should do, to bolster First's body of knowledge on some of the songs that we know we can sing together.
 - a. Also, I think it would be great to put a praise band together. If you know of anyone that is interested in being involved, let me know. Commitment would be practicing once a month for about an hour and leading worship once a month.


